Holistic Leadership was founded by Sue Howard in 2008. Sue is co-author of the Spirit at Work Phenomenon (Azure, 2004). Written from a UK perspective, the book provides an overview of the rising wave of interest in 'spirituality' and why the desire for more spirit-friendly workplaces is growing. The book itself has received acclaim from readers around the world, and was ranked as number 1 in a list of top 20 Spirit in Business books by the European business magazine 'Trends'. Amongst other publications, Sue contributed, as a 'Thinker of Tomorrow', to the book 'Beyond—Business and Society in Transformation' (Raich & Dolan, Palgrave MacMillan, 2008). In her role as Director of Corporate Affairs for the Academic Journal of Management, Spirituality and Religion (www.jmsr.com), Sue has co-ordinated workshops with leading academics and practitioners in post-graduate management contexts such as Ashridge and Cass Business Schools and Roffey Park Management Institute. Sue continues to be a pioneer, combining leadership development work with her PhD studies—both of which use the Holistic Development Model as a personal leadership framework, exploring how the spiritual dimension is an important facet of leadership in every-day life and work. Previously, Sue worked within the School of Management at Cranfield University, and with the global NGO World Vision. She has spoken at both international and UK conferences, and serves as Board Trustee of national charity MODEM (www.modem-uk.org)

The Pari Center for New Learning (www.paricenter.com)

The Center was founded by David Peat in 2000 in the medieval hilltop village of Pari, south of Siena. The surrounding area is blessed with a mild Mediterranean climate, wonderful nature, great art (Siena, Florence, Arezzo, Assisi, Perugia are all within reach in a day trip) and is famous for its food and wine (Montalcino is less than an hour away). The center is a special alchemical crucible, combining a strong sense of the 'spirit of the place', a connection with local history and tradition, and a markedly cosmopolitan, 'global village' consciousness. It fosters an interdisciplinary approach linking science, arts, ecology, ethics and spirituality. It offers courses and workshops, and hosts scientists, artists and writers who wish to spend some time in a peaceful and nourishing environment, while at the same time enjoying stimulating intellectual exchanges. In addition to its residential courses and visitors programme, the Center has run a number of international conferences including the Dialogues between Science and Religion series (It was a three time winner of the Metanexus award for excellence in its programming) and an Ethical Choices in Society, the Economy and the Environment conference held in Siena in 2006.

F. David Peat, the Center's director, is a former theoretical physicist and author of twenty books. He was an associate of David Bohm and is a Fellow of the World Academy of Art and Science.
